Development Issues in Tanzania

- ➤ Lack of human resources with technical background and skills (Human resource development for mechanics)
- Insufficient infrastructures for car maintenance that makes it difficult to own cars without concerns (Development of auto industry)

Company's Products & Services

- Auto mechanics and engineers with experiences in handling different types of cars from different manufacturers including those with advanced functions
- ➤ Maintenance services that require advanced techniques not available in maintenance garages in Tanzania
- > Stable supply of secondhand auto parts

Business Development Plans



- 1. Establishment of mechanic information center ⇒ To be operated in cooperation with NIT as a public system
- 2. Networking with maintenance service providers and securing of staff by providing training courses on hybrid vehicles as well as automotive mechanic training programs to automotive maintenance training institutions ⇒ Training courses are provided to trainers and trainees of automotive maintenance training institutions, TEMESA staff members and general automotive maintenance service providers either for free or fees.
- 3. Securing of revenue through provision of services to Japanese companies including used-car exporters and tighter relationship with automotive maintenance institutions in Tanzania ⇒ Automobile users in Tanzania can purchase used cars exported from Japan without concerns because of after-sales services to be provided locally by Saint Parts.

Contributions to Tanzania



- > Convenience and safety of automobile users in Tanzania can be greatly enhanced.
- ➤ Automobile users can own and use environmentally-friendly vehicles with higher confidence, and a larger ratio of such vehicles will be used in Tanzania, which leads to less environmental burden in the country.
- ➤ Auto mechanics in Tanzania can stably purchase Japanese secondhand auto parts, and can expand their business accordingly, which should create more employment opportunities.
